Board

On June 17th a Congregational Meeting was held at Tansley. This meeting was to deal with the following motion.

“That Tansley United Church enter into formal discussions with St. Stephen United Church for the purpose of amalgamating our congregations. A joint amalgamation team with an equal number of members from St. Stephen and Tansley to be enacted within 1 month (by July 17, 2018). The task of this team is to perform due diligence to give each congregation all required facts in order to make a final amalgamation decision by congregational vote, post July 17, 2018. If all parties are in agreement at that time, then the amalgamation will be scheduled to occur on or before June 30, 2019.”

After discussion, the vote was taken with the following results:

63 in favour of the motion
4 opposed to the motions
0 abstentions

What happens now?

A joint team has been organized consisting of Mark Goodale, Dale Martin and May Turner from Tansley and Paul Bartu, Heather McGavin, and Dave Shilton from St. Stephen. They will begin meeting no later than July 17 with the purpose of performing due diligence. An email will be set up shortly allowing for the submission of comments and/or questions.
